Marcin Pater Trio is an original project inspired by European jazz, with the vibraphone as the central element shaping the band's sound. The group's music draws from jazz, jazz-rock, and world music, creating a cohesive and expressive sonic landscape. The trio's distinctive sound is built on the combination of vibraphone, double bass/electric bass, and drums.

In 2019, the band completed at 12-date concert tour in China, performing at renowned concert halls and jazz festivals.



Collaboration with Leszek Możdżer

The Grand Prix award at the Jazz Nad Odrą competition (2020) led to a collaboration with Leszek Możdżer. This resulted in the project ***Marcin Pater Trio & Leszek Możdżer feat. Jakub Mizeracki***, which became an important step in shaping the band's sound.

In February 2022, the musicians recorded original material composed by Marcin Pater, released as the album ***Between*** (2022). The recording features Leszek Możdżer, with guitarist Jakub Mizeracki appearing as a guest.

The session took place in Warsaw and was engineered by Tadeusz Mieczkowski. The project premiered at the ***NOSPR Concert Hall*** in Katowice.



Current Projects

The band is actively performing, presenting material from the album *Between*, and appears in various formats depending on the context – as a trio, a quartet (featuring Jakub Mizeracki), and in an extended line-up with Leszek Możdżer.

The group has recently completed work on its third album, further developing its original sonic concept based on the combination of acoustic and processed vibraphone sound. The material was recorded at the Polish Radio studio and once again engineered by Tadeusz Mieczkowski.

The recording features ***Marta Wajdzik, Jakub Mizeracki, Daniel Cebula-Orynicz, and Alicja Stokłosa.***

The album is scheduled for release in **2026.**
